This instructor has authored technical publications in the areas of Linux administration, document management, E-mail, document interpretation, groupware workflow and productivity, NetWare design and implementation, eDirectory, project management, and corporate productivity training through Franklin Covey; beginning in October 2003, he also authors the monthly column "Tips and Hints" for Novell's *CNI Express Newsletter*. Currently, working with Novell Training Services and Novell's Customer Communities in Novell's Linux initiative to write and teach three different Linux courses in 20 cities nation-wide. And has developed a 5-day Linux Certification Boot Camp, teaching coast-to-coast preparing CNE's and CNI's to pass the LPI exams and CLP practicum in order to teach the newer Linux courses such as SuSE Linux Fundamentals 3036, Linux Administration 3037, and Advanced Linux Administration 3038.

As an independent contractor this instructor works directly with Novell to develop four GroupWise 5 & 6 courses. He then taught these courses to Novell staff (Novell SE's and the NetWare developers). While, working with Sr. Novell Instructional Designer to develop and teach the first beta course for NetWare 6. In October 2001, Novell Education recognized his new two-day GroupWise 5 to 6 Update curriculum as a new course using some materials from the five-day GroupWise 6 administration course, including posting it as a course on the Novell Education Locator.

He has trained Novell's corporate clients' IT departments and system engineers throughout the United States and graduates approximately 150 new Linux, NetWare 6 Z.E.N., GroupWise administrators every year as well as contracts on-site installation, customization and has supervised design and implementation sessions.
